Mission

ShivteYah Farm is a Jewish holistic-health sanctuary in Bat Shlomo, Israel, integrating treatment rooms, a medicinal garden, a 120-seat conference center, and a farm-to-table café — woven into the rhythm of land and tradition.

Location & Setting

Set in the historic moshava of Bat Shlomo, Israel (est. 1889), the farm sits on the edge of the Galilee, surrounded by vineyards, olive groves, and oak forest. The site combines restored stone buildings with new timber pavilions.

Programs & Revenue Streams

- Treatment rooms (herbalism, bodywork, somatic therapy)
- Medicinal garden tours, classes, and apothecary sales
- 120-seat conference center for retreats and gatherings
- Farm-to-table café and dining hall
- Wellness rooms & on-site housing
- Healing concerts on the open-air Niggun Stage
- Practitioner residencies and cohort programs

Partnerships

Holy Land Herbs (medicinal cultivation & apothecary), To Work and To Guard (land stewardship), and Fruit Trees 4 Israel (orchard restoration).
